Establishing Your Identity

If you are approved for the WINNpass program you will be asked to show documentation to prove your identity upon picking-up your WINNpass peggo card from one of our Winnipeg Transit Customer Service Centres.

To prove your identity, you will need documentation that establishes the following elements:

- Birth date
- Full legal name
- Winnipeg residence

Acceptable supporting documents

You can use a wide range of documents to prove each part of your identity when receiving your WINNpass peggo card. Each piece of identification must be from an authority such as a federal government, province or federal agency. They must also be originals – not photocopies.
