## How to Book a Winnipeg Transit Plus Trip

Winnipeg Transit Plus trips may be requested up to one week in advance, and until 5 p.m. the day before travel. Trips can be booked by:

- Calling the Contact Center at **205-986-5722**,
- Using the 24/7 automated phone service at **204-986-5711**, or
- Downloading the **Winnipeg Transit+ On – Request** app.

When requesting a Transit Plus ride, it's best to have the following ready:

- Your name and Transit Plus registration number,
- Date & time you want to arrive at destination,
- Exact address and location (building entrance, etc.) of both pickup & drop off including unit number of each location,
- The time you want to be picked up for return trip,
- If you are travelling with a guest/ companion,
- What mobility equipment will you be using during transportation.

After booking your ride, please call the contact center as soon as possible to inform of any changes to your trip. This could be a change in mobility equipment or to add/remove a guest.

## Travel Tips for Spring
